The Expo is located on Loop 121 which crosses IH 35 in Belton.

SHOW RULES

ARBA SHOW RULES SECTION 15: A host club MUST REFUSE entries from exhibitors placing an entry from all locations within 50 miles, which had a confirmed outbreak of RCV/RHD/VHD in domestic rabbits and from exhibitors placing an entry from all locations within 25 miles, which had a confirmed outbreak of RCV/RHD/VHD in wild / feral rabbits within the past 30 days of the entry deadline.

ENTRIES

- This is an official ARBA & TRBA Sanctioned Show & will be governed by the latest show rules.
- Entries must be entered online by March 24, 2023. This includes all rabbits, cavies, and banquet tickets. No late entries will be accepted. **Deadline will be strictly enforced.**
- Animal entry signifies acceptance of show rules which will be available in the showroom.
- All exhibitors must check in with show secretary's office no later than 7:00 a.m. April 1st. Building will open 6:00am.
- Substitutions will be allowed by email at no charge and must be received by Sunday March 26th 8pm - NO EXCEPTIONS. Substitutions after this time will be limited to Ear changes only and at \$1.50 each.
- Completed Youth Royalty contest application with an additional copy plus one 4 x 6 or smaller photo must be postmarked by March 1, and mailed to: Jennifer Schimpf, 2301 Woodgate Dr. Apt 702, Waco, TX 76712. Individual youth contestants (not entered in royalty) must be registered by March 24, 2023 to youthco.texasrba@gmail.com. Forms and additional information available in this catalog.

GENERAL

- Any rabbit/cavy showing signs of sickness or disease will be removed from the showroom and will not be judged. Entry fee will be forfeited
- All rabbits must meet minimum breed standard weight. NO DOES WITH LITTERS.
- This is an Early Entry carrying cage show and rabbits must be in leak proof carriers.
- No animals other than rabbits, cavies and SERVICE ANIMALS will be allowed in the show building.
- It is the exhibitor's responsibility to get the animal to the judging table. Animals will be called three (3) times and if not present will be scratched with no refunds.
- Judges decisions will be final. No harassing of any judge will be allowed.
- The TRBA Show Committee reserves the right to make any changes necessary, including substitution, addition or deletion of any judge.
- Only rented and TRBA sponsored booths will be allowed to set-up in the building. Sale of any type merchandise or any other items will not be allowed unless booth space has been approved and rented. No raffles other than those sponsored by TRBA will be allowed.
- NO COOLERS, COFFEE POTS, FOOD, ETC. WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING. IF YOU BRING ANY OF THESE TYPES OF ITEMS INTO THE BUILDING, YOU WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION AS DETERMINED BY THE SHOW COMMITTEE AND TRBA BOARD.
- The TRBA and Bell County Expo will not be responsible for any loss or damage.

Service Animals

Texas Disability Law

Excerpts below taken from: https://gov.texas.gov/organization/disabilities/assistance_animals

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Title II & Title III

- Under the ADA, Title II and III, a service animal must be a dog (or miniature horse) that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability. Service animals can be professionally trained or trained by the handler themselves.
- Under Title II and Title III, a service animal handler does not need to provide certification for their service animal.
- Title I of the ADA, regarding employment, does not specifically address service animals in the workplace. Under Title I, a service animal may be a reasonable accommodation. As such, professional written verification may be requested by an employer when it is not obvious that the animal is a service animal.
- A comfort or emotional support animal is NOT trained. Comfort animals do not have rights under the ADA. For example, businesses do not have the legal obligation to admit a comfort animal if there is a "no pets" policy, as under the ADA these animals are in essence "pets."

Texas Health & Safety Code

If a service animal is accompanied by a person whose disability is not readily apparent, for purposes of admittance to a food service establishment, retail food store, or physical space occupied by another entity, a staff member of the establishment, store, or entity may only inquire about:

- Whether the service animal is required because the person has a disability; and
- what type of work the service animal is trained to perform.

"Service animal" in this context means a canine that is specially trained or equipped to help a person with a disability. An animal that provides only comfort or emotional support to a person is not a service animal. The tasks that a service animal may perform in order to help a person with a disability are directly related to the person's disability.

Americans with Disabilities Act

When can service animals be excluded?

The ADA does not require covered entities to modify policies, practices, or procedures if it would "fundamentally alter" the nature of the goods, services, programs, or activities provided to the public. Nor does it overrule legitimate safety requirements. If admitting service animals would fundamentally alter the nature of a service or program, service animals may be prohibited. In addition, if a particular service animal is out of control and the handler does not take effective action to control it, or if it is not housebroken, that animal may be excluded.

NO PETS ALLOWED. SERVICE ANIMALS ONLY.

When might a service dog's presence fundamentally alter the nature of a service or program provided to the public?

In most settings, the presence of a service animal will not result in a fundamental alteration. However, there are some exceptions. At a zoo, service animals can be restricted from areas where the animals on display are the natural prey or natural predators of dogs, where the presence of a dog would be disruptive, causing the displayed animals to behave aggressively or become agitated. They cannot be restricted from other areas of the zoo.

The ADA requires that service animals be under the control of the handler at all times. If a service animal is out of control and the handler does not take effective action to control it, staff may request that the animal be removed from the premises.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be a current youth member of Texas Rabbit Breeders Association and attend the TRBA State Convention.

CONTESTS

The following contests are the Saturday of the TRBA State Show in Belton. Applicants can choose to enter Royalty or any combination of Individual Contests available for their age division. Awards provided to the top three for each contest in each age division. There is one royalty winner for each division. There is no cost to participate. However, all contestants must register by the appropriate deadlines. Royalty has an earlier deadline to allow time to score the applications.

Determined by the age on the closing day of the annual TRBA State Show (April 2, 2023)

Breed Identification (All ages)

Contestants will identify a number of animals, both rabbits and cavies, listing the complete breed name as printed in the ARBA Standard of Perfection, the showroom variety, whether a 4-class or 6-class breed, and the registration variety of each animal. The ARBA Official Breed ID Guide (found on ARBA website) is used to score.

Written Test (All ages)

Examination questions will be drawn from the ARBA Official Guidebook to Raising Better Rabbits and Cavies, the ARBA Yearbook, ARBA Standard of Perfection, current issues of the Domestic Rabbit magazine and current issues of the TRBA News. Questions are in multiple choice, true/false, matching, and short-answer formats.

Quiz Bowl (Pre-Jr & Juniors)

Contestants will participate in a Jeopardy-type competition, demonstrating their rabbit and cavy knowledge.

Showmanship (Rabbit - Pre-Jr & Juniors, Cavy - All ages)

Contestants will examine and evaluate an animal, telling the judge what they are doing and why as they go along. The ARBA showmanship scorecard will be used.

Judging (Intermediate & Seniors)

Contestant will place two classes of four animals per class. This may include breeding rabbits, market classes, or cavies.

Royalty (All ages)

Composite score of application and all age-appropriate contests.




